Camp every year over 1000 campers are engaged in
learning about Christ through recreation in a natural
setting free from city and secular influences. Over 80
young adults are trained and mentored as leaders of
spiritual influence to guide the campers. Last summer
255 campers requested baptism and 118 made a decision, at this critical age in their life to follow Christ.

BECAUSE OF YOU... Indian Creek Camp has had many improvements over the years:

In 1998/9 new cabins were built.

In 2005 a new wing was added to the cafeteria with a larger kitchen and dining area.

In 2009 a new chapel was built to accommodate more people.

In 2010 the gymnasium was rebuilt and updated. In 2014 a waterslide and high dive was added to the swimming pool area.

In 2016 a new maintenance shop was built.

In 2017 a zip line and climbing wall were built to add other activities to the camp.

This years improvements are: a new horse barn is being built, RV spaces are being added and renovations and updates on the 21-year-old cabins will begin.
