

I found out that they were not open so that kind of put a damper on my morning since I love to work out. I decided to go and start my day advertising and then knock on doors. I went to a hospital and found out that some of the doctors' offices were in fact still allowing me to put my books in and then there were many that I couldn't. I advertised for about 3 hours until I was at the point of needing a break from the virus. I went to knock on doors, but didn't really find anyone that would allow me in. I went to seek out a lead in Powell, TN. I didn't recognize the name but when I got there, I remembered that I had already been there and talked to a man before. I said, "why not," and went to his door anyway. The first time he didn't buy so I decided for a second time. I did remember that he was a lonely old man from the military and he did like to talk. I got to his door and didn't even knock when he asked me what I needed. I asked for him and he allowed me to come in right away. He began to talk and I didn't say much, but just listened to him. Well, after showing him the new health set of books we have, and --many stories in between-- I ended up selling him a \$474 package. I left amazed because I knew what to expect but I didn't expect the sale.



Wednesday I decided to stay in my town Lafollette, Tennessee and advertised as much as I could. I normally have about 60 offices but was only able to get in about 15-20 offices. After doing that I went out and started knocking on doors. So, I went to a bible story lead and when I got there I realized they were apartments. Normally it's not a big deal but the lead card didn't have an apartment number. It just so happened that the maintenance man was outside. We talked for a bit, and he openly gave me the apartment number. I got out of my car and gave him a Hope and Happiness. The maintenance man told me that he couldn't read or write. I was sad for him told him maybe someone could read it to him. He got a smile on his face and said that would be great. So I went and knocked on the door about 8 times trying to get them to come to the door to no avail.

I left and went to a little town north of Lafollette to find health lead. I found the house and they let me in. I just love health leads. Sometimes they can be the greatest leads. I sat down on their porch and started to talk to them. After a while they opened up to me and told me that she had a lung partly removed and had many other ailments. I brought in the new health set of books and after talking to her I realized that this set really wasn't going to work for her, so I went out and exchanged it for the food books set. I went in and started showing them the books and she just loved them. As I was talking to them both I learned a lot of information about the two of them. After about 1.5 hours of being there, they invested in a \$453 set right away. What a blessing!

I later went back to the bible lead that I was at and talked with her and after a few minutes or so she purchased the \$230 set of the CCC. I went around to knock on a health lead's doors with little success. After searching for souls, I went into a trucking area and found a house. I'm not sure about the house or address I went up and knocked on. The woman at the door was scared of the virus, so I stayed outside and talked to her through the door. She was about six feet away from me and as I continued to talk to her she warmed up to me and got closer. Well, I ended up selling her a \$499 set and as she talked with me, she told me that after 42 years of filling out those cards I was the first one to come to her door and sell it to her. She wanted them when she was young with her children. Her oldest is 42 years old now. She told me every time she went into the doctor's office she would look for the books and read them. What a blessing to be able to give those to her after 42 years. She also told me that she was looking for a book that had questions and answers about the Bible. Steve at HHES had a set of Bible Readings for the Home, so she will be getting that too.

I headed back to an appointment I had in my town and shared the bible stories with a young family. The man is a truck driver and so he and I connected right away, being I'm an ex-truck driver. What a beautiful family. They wanted a set for their kids. The 8 year-old went in and came out with all the money she had to buy the books. Of course that wasn't nowhere enough for the books but I loved how much she really wanted them. I ended up selling them a \$492 package and when paid off they want the family bibles too.

God is out there with us. We are to be the light in the midst of the darkness. May God bless you as you go out and work for HIM! He will protect you from this and every other disease that comes upon us in this world.
