For you were called to freedom brothers. Only do not use your freedom as an opportunity for the flesh, but through love serve one another. Galatians 5:13

Do nothing from selfish ambition or conceit, but in humility count others more significant than yourself. Let each of you look not only to his own interests, but also to the interests of others. Philippians 2:3-4

Day 1 - Pray that God bless your husband's heart; not just for your family but for those at his work, for those within your church congregation, and for the community you are called to serve. Pray he use his freedom in Christ to serve others as Christ served with love.

Day 2 - Pray he considers the interests of you and your children before making any major decisions. Pray that God give him a humble spirit he needs to accomplish this service of love for the world he lives in.

Day 3 - Pray that God gives you the desire to serve your world, your husband, and your family as well. Pray that God continually reminds you to consider others rather than yourself as you work with your husband in your decisions or as you are faced with decisions in your work place.

Day 4 - Pray that God gives you both the ability to count others' needs as more significant than your needs giving you a true heart of service rather than only acting in service once your needs are met. Remember that God promises to take care of your needs as you take care of others making personal sacrifice for others.

Day 5 - Pray that the Lord continually reminds your husband that his freedom is found in Christ and His sacrifice and that he can claim his salvation in Christ with confidence. Pray that he recognizes his mistakes and humble his spirit to not take advantage of this freedom for his own purposes but to continually put the needs of others first.
