*But seek first the kingdom of God and His righteousness and all these things will be added to you. Matthew 6:33*

*You shall love the Lord your God with all your heart and with all your soul and with all your might. Deutoronomy 6:5*

*Be very careful, then, how you live—not as unwise but as wise, making the best use of the time, because the days are evil. Ephesians 5:15,16*

*So teach us to number our days that we may get a heart of wisdom. Psalm 90:12*

Day 1 - Pray that God grants your husband contentment with what he has. He may want shinier and newer but if what you have is working, pray God helps him be at peace so that he can spend his time and money furthering the kingdom of God.

Day 2 - Pray that God gives him a deep and undying love for the Lord so that he will want to further God's kingdom and desire to make wise decisions especially in such a lost world.

Day 3 - Pray for your own heart that God gives you the desire and ability to make wise decisions for you and your family and also the desire to further God's kingdom rather than the pursuit of worldly riches.

Day 4 - Pray that God makes your husband a kingdom minded man with a deep desire to further God's kingdom and witness in his everyday life. Pray that he finds joy in what he has and the people in his life. Pray that God works on his heart to want eternal things rather than material things.

Day 5 - Pray that the Lord gives your husband wisdom as he learns the joy of letting God fulfill his needs. Pray he rejects materialism and temporal values putting the Lord first in his own life and in the life of his family. Grant him the wisdom to know when to reject materialism but to provide the best he can for his family. Pray that God gives him the wisdom to know and see that fine line.
